






Early Questions about HOO










Do professional optics volunteers need training? We already know optics!!

- The training workshops provide places for the OPVs to meet the teachers and MESA Staff.








Why is volunteering for HOO easy? The HOO programs provide everything a OPV






Events at Local Schools

MESA Sponsored Competitions now includes telescopes








An OPV judging a telescope

Closing Comments & Future Efforts


- Not all MESA Centers are the same.
